In the originally published version of this manuscript, in section **Discussion**, fourth paragraph, the 7th sentence should read: ““However the relationship is likely affected by the use of a single-item question from the PSYRATS to assess voice-related distress.”

instead of: “However the relationship with voice frequency is likely affected by the use of a single-item

question from the PSYRATS to assess voice-related distress.”

In the **Supplementary Data** section, the phrasing of two items in the last questionnaire are incorrect in file *sbac101_suppl_Supplementary_Materials_2*. In the questionnaire on p. 14, Listening and believing – Reasons (L&B-R-5), the second statement completion should read: “I’m trying to figure out why this is happening” instead of “I feel defeated by them”. The fifth statement completion should read: “The voice knows more than I do so I might learn something” instead of: “I don’t have the confidence to ignore the nasty voices”.

These errors have been emended in the article online.
