Individuals of either sex eligible for vaccination in an education setting (including home schooled children, and children not in mainstream schools) between the ages of 11-17	Studies failing to report vaccine uptake quantitatively
Studies including ages outside 11-17 will be included provided the data from the eligible age group can be separated.	Studies that don't examine HPV vaccine uptake with behaviour change interventions or usual care
Studies from September 2008 onwards (when the UK first introduced the HPV vaccine)	Studies not published in English
Randomised (and cluster-randomised) controlled trials	Studies that are not peer reviewed and all other study designs
Studies in High Income Countries as named in the World Bank 2023 list	Studies that fail to distinguish HPV vaccination from general vaccination programmes
Studies administered by any health provider, provided this is in an education setting
