

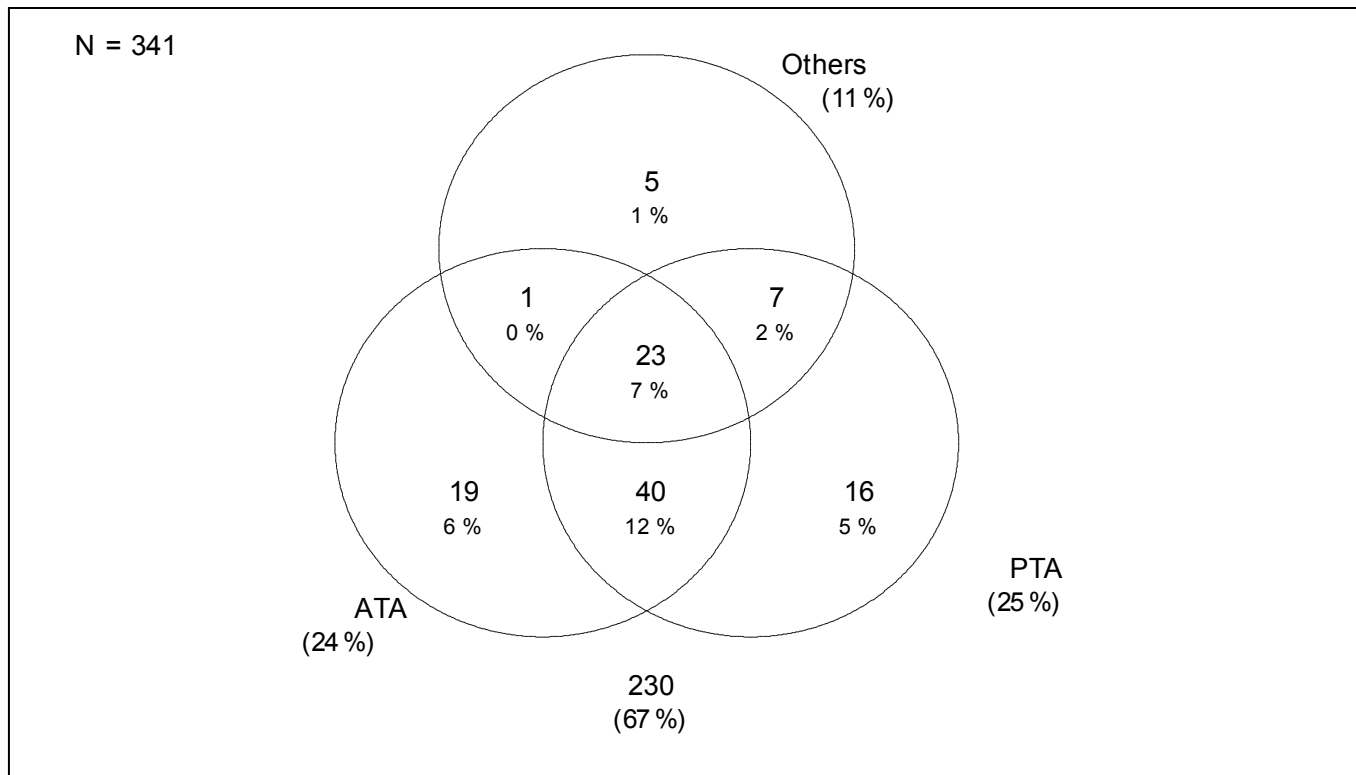


Figure 2: Prevalence of the different vascular beds involved in lower leg arterial calcifications (LLAC).
