

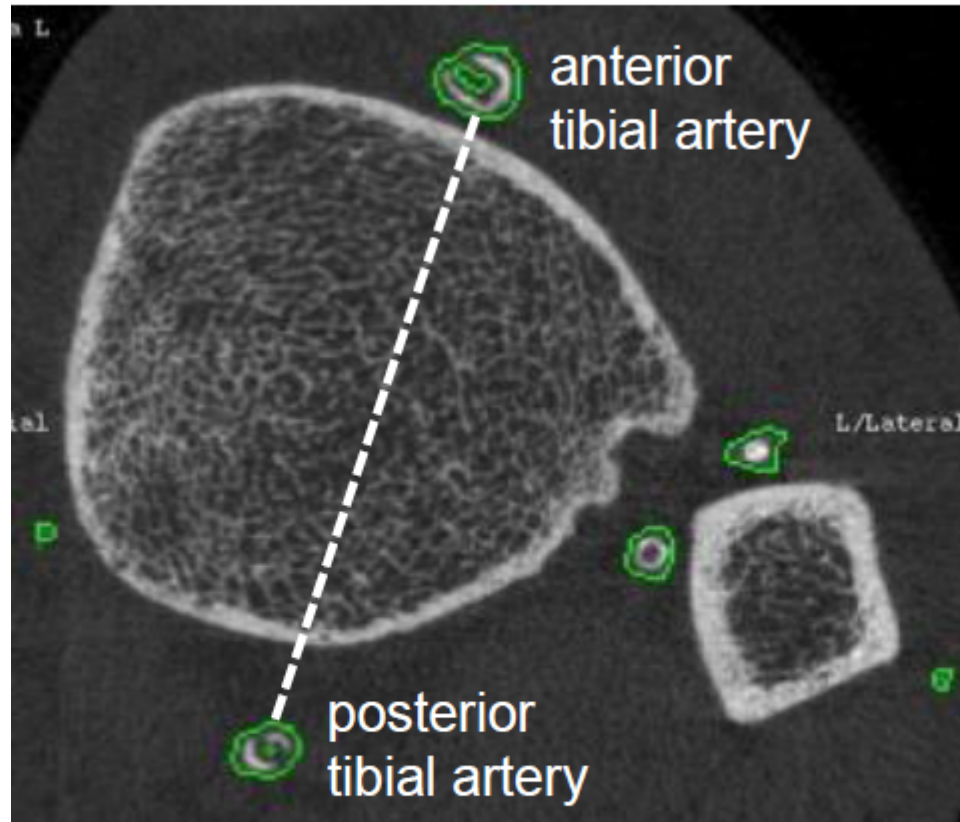


Figure 1: presence of lower leg arterial calcification
