### Unfunded? Three options:

1. Publish in a platinum/diamond OA journal – These journals subsidise their publication fees and do not have article processing charges see: DOAJ – Journals with no APC (<https://bit.ly/3Af2cu8>)
2. Publish in a journal covered by a University of Oxford publisher agreement (<https://openaccess.ox.ac.uk/publisher-deals/>)
3. Publish in a journal which allows deposit via the OA Green route (search Sherpa Romeo for an outline of journal's green route permissions - <https://v2.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo/>) and 'Act on Acceptance' to deposit your manuscript into the Oxford University Research Archive (<https://openaccess.ox.ac.uk/home-2/act-on-acceptance/>)

## Sherpa Romeo et al

**Sherpa Romeo** (<https://v2.sherpa.ac.uk/romeo/>) – Check Publisher copyright policies & self-archiving for open access.

**Sherpa Juliet** (<https://v2.sherpa.ac.uk/juliet/>) – See funders' conditions for open access publication.

**Sherpa FACT – Funder and Authors Compliance Tool** (<https://v2.sherpa.ac.uk/fact/>) – To allow researchers to check if the journals in which they wish to publish their results comply with their funder's requirements for Open Access

**Journal Checker Tool** (<https://journalcheckertool.org/>) **separate** tool for certain funders (Plan S compliance)

## REF/Act on Acceptance

Act on Acceptance – deposit the accepted manuscript into our repository ORA within 3 months of acceptance (<https://openaccess.ox.ac.uk/home-2/act-on-acceptance/>) – we don't know what the next REF will look like yet so keep depositing as per the old REF
