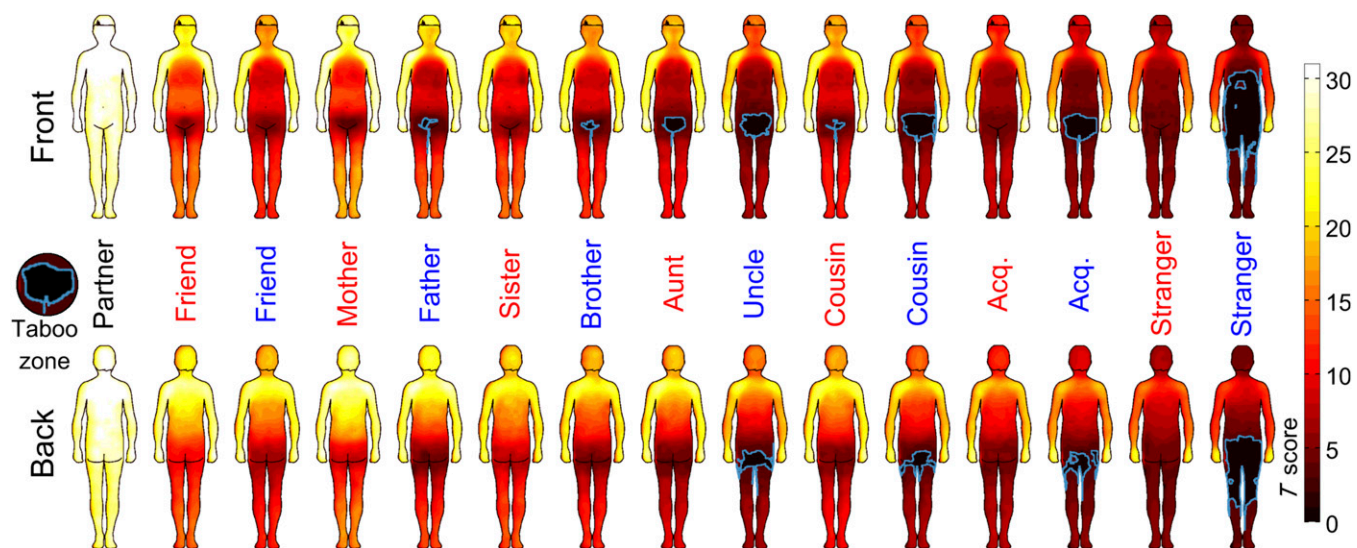


Fig. 1. Relationship-specific TAMs across all studied countries ($n = 1,368$ individuals). The blue-outlined black areas highlight the taboo zones, where a person with that relationship is not allowed to touch. The data are thresholded at $P < 0.05$, FDR-corrected. Color bar indicates the t statistic range. Blue and red labels signify males and females, respectively.

The authors note that, due to a printer’s error, the legend for Fig. 1 appeared incorrectly. The figure and its corrected legend appear below.
